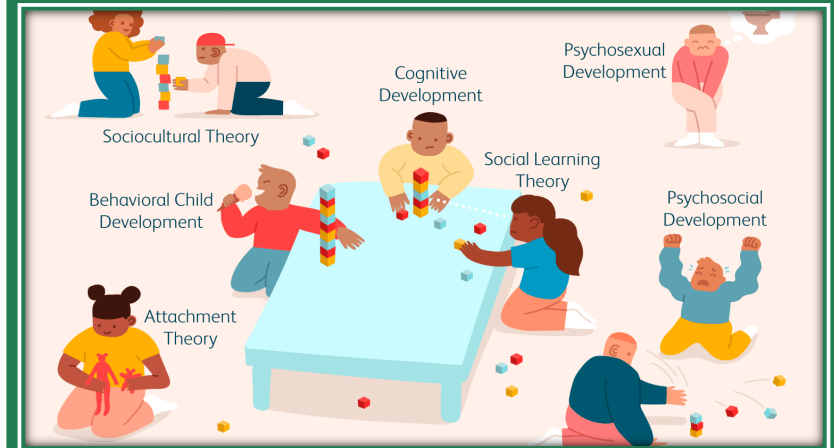
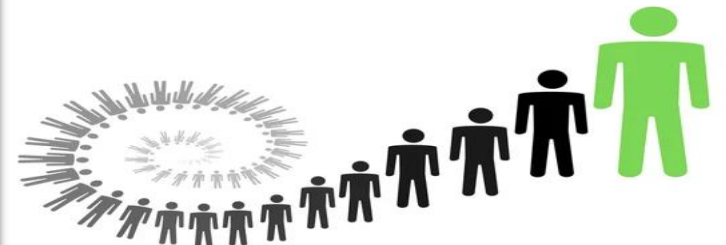


HDFE Department

- ▶ The department was initially called **Family and Child Welfare** (FCW) though later the nomenclature was changed to Human Development & Family Empowerment (HDFE).
- ▶ The department has been actively engaged with the discipline of Human Development through academics as well as curricular activities.

“UTKARSH”- THE DEPARTMENT SOCIETY

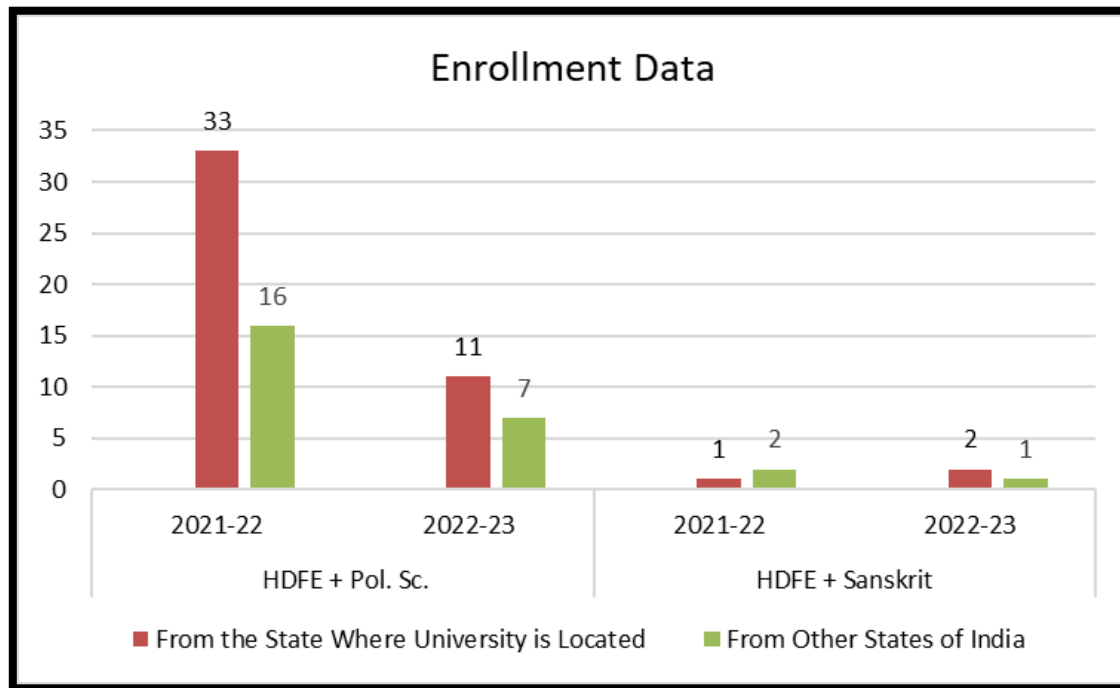

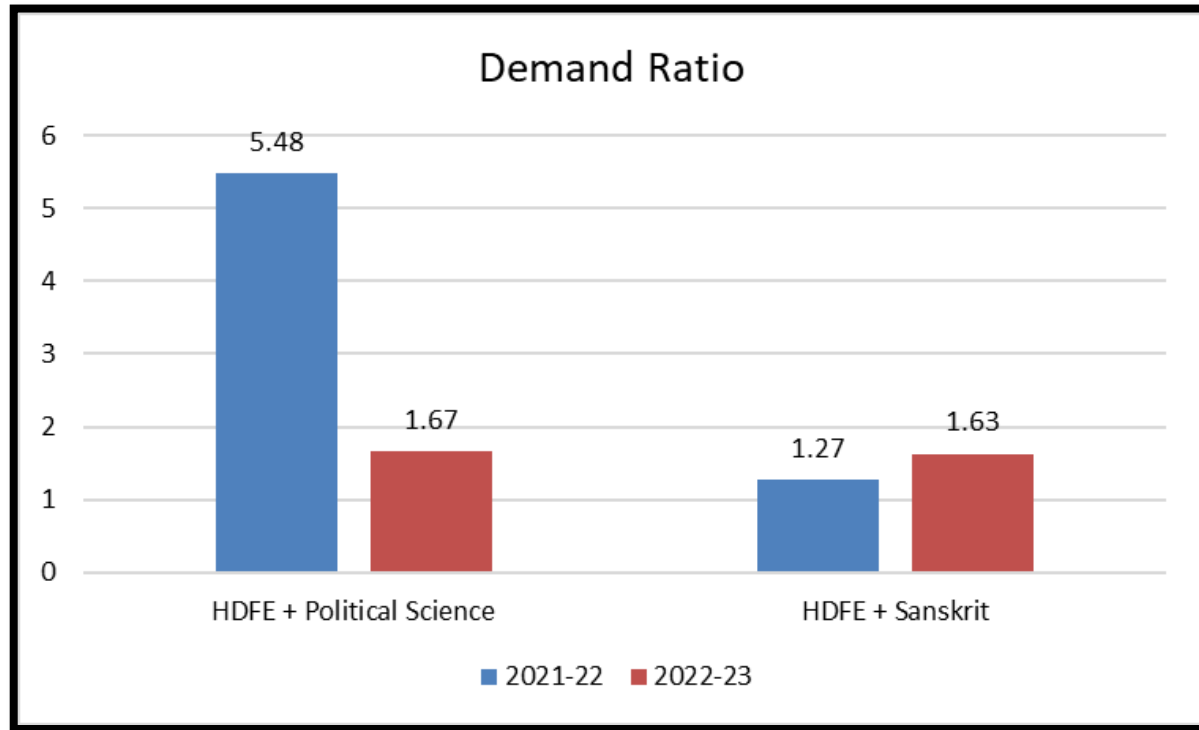

Overall Demand Ratio

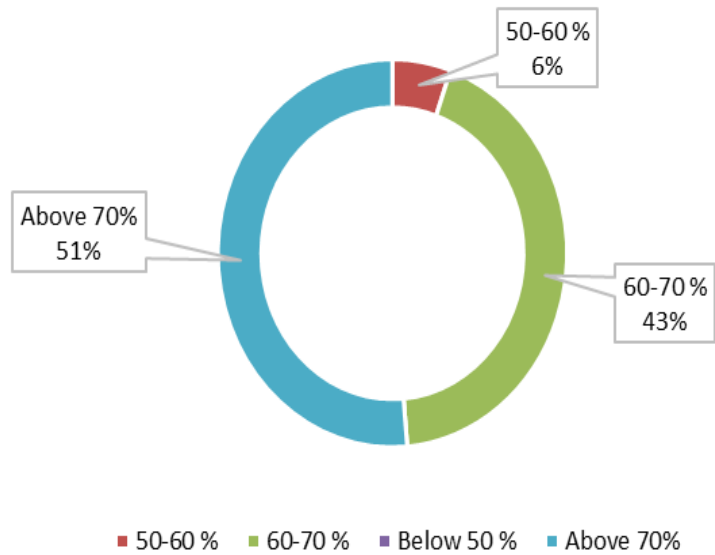


- Demand ratio represents the no. of application per intake capacity
- Overall application count dropped in 2022-23

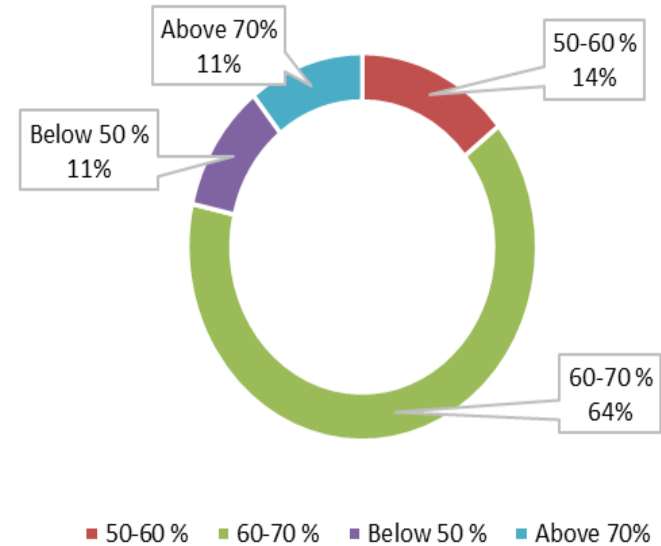
Result Analysis



Success Rate (2021-22)



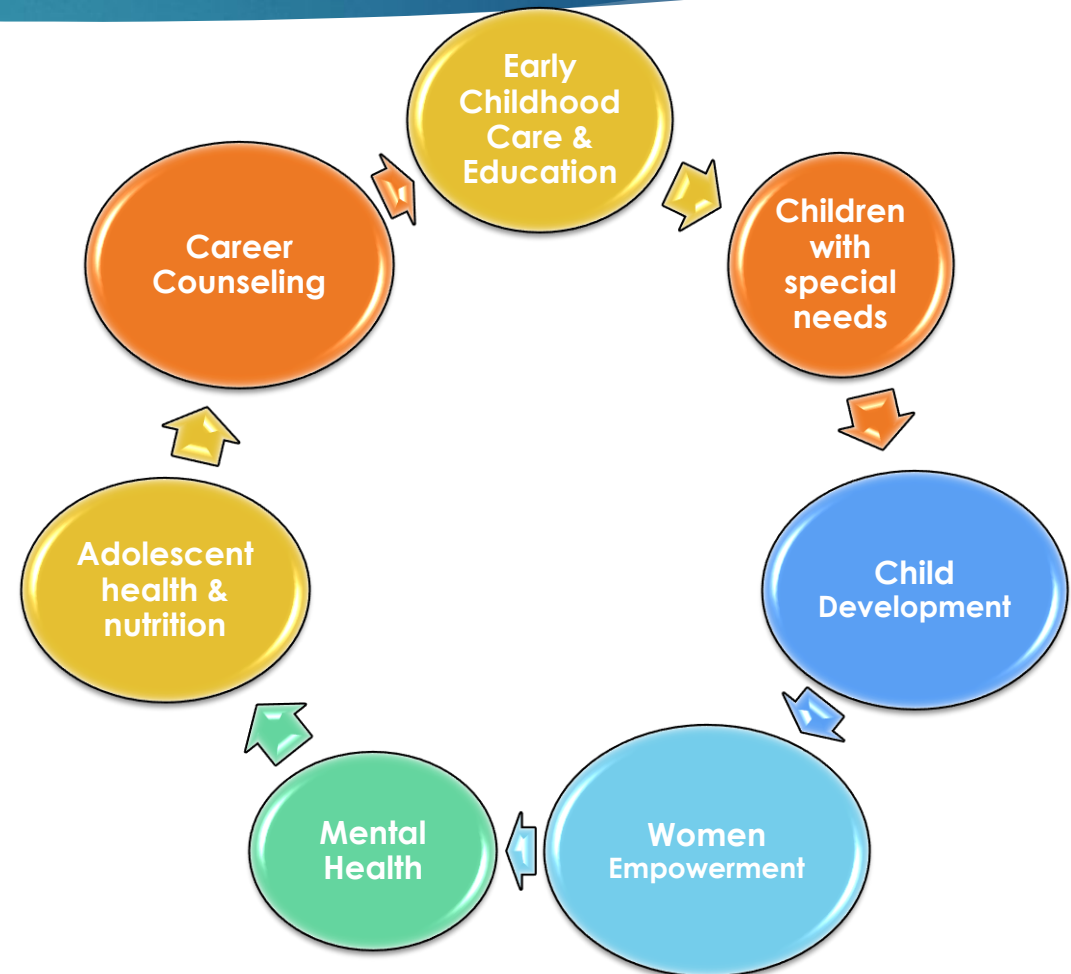
Success Rate (2022-23)

Strengths:

- Qualified and experienced faculty members
- Promising students participation
- Innovative teaching skills
- Experience of working with NGOs to get hands on experience from the field

Opportunities:

- Partnership with Corporates to drive CSR projects in the area of early education, child rights, disability etc.
- Collaborate with International Universities for student exchange program.

Weakness:

- Limited campus placement
- Limited higher education opportunities for students
- Flexibility of introducing HDFE subjects with different combinations like Psychology, Sociology

Challenges:

- With online admission, student intake ratio is going down
- Need for more faculty members to run the department properly
- Limited /short duration of the semester limits in-depth knowledge sharing with the students

Suggested Road map

- ▶ Plan to strengthen the community outreach activities to move from voluntarily to a regular credit-based activity for students.
- ▶ Participate in more research-based initiatives to provide wider exposure to students
- ▶ Engage students in projects / internship opportunities by collaborating with National / International Institutions
