
HDFE Department

"UTKARSH"- THE DEPARTMENT SOCIETY






Overall Demand Ratio




- Demand ratio represents the no. of application per intake capacity

Result Analysis





Strengths:

Weakness:

- Limited campus placement
- Limited higher education opportunities for students
- Flexibility of introducing HDFE subjects with different combinations like Psychology, Sociology

Challenges:

- With online admission, student intake ratio is going down
- Need for more faculty members to run the department properly
- Limited /short duration of the semester limits in-depth knowledge sharing with the students

Suggested Road map

- Plan to strengthen the community outreach activities to move from voluntarily to a regular credit-based activity for students.
- Participate in more research-based initiatives to provide wider exposure to students
- Engage students in projects / internship opportunities by collaborating with National / International Institutions
