






- The Department of Sociology was established in 2017 with two faculty members, a teacher-in-charge from Political Science Department, and about 35 students.





### **OVERALL DEMAND RATIO**



### **Challenges**


- Students often struggle to establish connections within the field of sociology during their first two semesters, grappling with the complexity of translated works from languages such as French and German.
- The initial phases of sociology courses are marked by difficulties as students grapple with the intricacies of memorising sociological concepts and vocabulary.
- Articulating sociological arguments in their answers is a challenge for students.

- Foster a collaborative and inclusive learning environment where students feel supported and encouraged to explore sociological concepts.
- Continuously assess and adapt pedagogical practices based on student feedback and emerging trends in the field of sociology.

Annually, the Department of Sociology conducts a democratic election to select members for Hestia from all three graduate years.






