The college has been accredited by NAAC score of 2.85 i.e. B grade.

During the academic year 2015-16, Internal Quality Assurance Cell (IQAC) was formulated to undertake the enhancement of quality education through internalization of quality culture and institutionalization of best practices.

The College has a large and well-equipped library with the latest text books, reference books and journals in various subjects and disciplines. This year 1342 books were added in the stock of Library making a total of 49,842 books. The library subscribes to 19 Newspapers in English and Hindi, 29 national and International journals and 20 magazines.
