- 8. Limited parking space availability.

### Recommendations received from the residents:

- 1. Implement regular cleanliness drives and awareness campaigns to promote cleanliness in the village.
- 2. Explore measures to reduce electricity and water bills, such as promoting energy-efficient practices and identifying water conservation methods.
- 3. Enhance safety measures through increased police patrolling and community engagement programs.
- 4. Allocate resources for park maintenance and encourage community participation in its upkeep.
- 5. Address water supply issues and improve sewage management systems.
- 6. Advocate for streamlined admission processes in schools to ensure equal opportunities for all children.
- 7. Monitor and ensure the availability of sufficient food resources in ration shops.
- 8. Evaluate the need for additional parking spaces and explore solutions to address the parking space issue.
